The first country chosen by Uzbekistan to participate in the Cultural Heritage Program, with a total budget of – 150 million, is (See: People's Word, February 20, 2018, № 34 (6992)).

By 2020, the European Union will have planned to implement a number of initiatives in the fields of food processing, water supply and small irrigation systems, farming, and energy, to develop rural areas within the framework of financial and technical support. A total of 168 million euros was allocated for this purpose [See: Publication of July 16, 2016, № 138 (6573)].

According to Z. Ashurova, "the Uzbek-European Parliamentary Cooperation Committee was established in 1999. The main task of the Oliy Majlis and the European Parliament, in particular, to strengthen the Uzbek-European relations is its important task "[See: People's Word, May 23, 2017, № 101 (6795)].

At present, the European Union's cooperation with Uzbekistan is characterized by various aspects, including the representatives of the European Parliament, the EU Special Representative for Central Asia, European Financial Institutions, the European External Action Service and many European Commission officials, which define

Inter-parliamentary groups have been set up to cooperate with Germany, Great Britain, Belgium, Canada, Japan, South Korea, Italy, France, Bulgaria, and Latvia. Last year (2017) Uzbekistan restored its membership in the Inter-Parliamentary Union. Parliamentary mechanisms of cooperation have become an effective tool for the establishment of parliamentary dialogue, exchange of experience, exchange of experience in the field of international and domestic policy of Uzbekistan, regional inter-parliamentary dialogue, trade and economic cooperation, innovative development, education, tourism. , №33 (6991) 1-2 pp]. The Committee supports the various initiatives of our country in the European Parliament and the European Union.

The Republic of Uzbekistan and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development have established extensive cooperation. Training seminars with participation of EBRD are held. An example of this is the seminar on "Mechanisms of interaction between the EBRD and small businesses" at the Entrepreneurs' Center in Ferghana [See: People's Word, June 20, 2017, №121 (6815)].

Cooperation between the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Kingdom of Spain in the economic and tourism spheres.

Relation between Uzbekistan and

Spain in Central Asia is well-known from the historical sources that Temur's era began. The foundations at that time were centuries-old, but they did not go unnoticed. In particular, after the independence of Uzbekistan, relations between these two countries have been restored. The two countries attach great importance to the development of economic, cultural and tourism spheres. There are briefings, conferences, forums and exhibitions dedicated to studying various topics. A conference titled "Uzbekistan: Opportunities for Economic Cooperation and Investments" was held in Barcelona (Spain) [See: People's Word, September 11, 2017, №71 (6765)]. Today, a number of Spanish companies are operating in Uzbekistan. The four Spanish high-speed trains, Talgo, are of great practical significance for our people and our country. Maksim is implementing promising projects in the chemical industry. Agreements on establishing long-term cooperation in tourism have been reached [See: People's Word, № 212, № 212 (6816)].

At the SCO summit in Astana, Kazakhstan, on 8-9 June 2017, the meeting between the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyayev and King Philippe VI of Spain became an important stage in the development of tourism for the parties. The relationship between Uzbekistan and Switzerland's cultural and economic cooperation.

The branch of the Turin Polytechnic University in Italy makes a worthwhile contribution to the training of specialists for Uzbekistan. In the long run, focusing on further expansion of economic, cultural and tourism cooperation between the two countries would have a positive impact on the mutual benefits.

Economic Cooperation between the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Kingdom of Sweden.

"People's Word" newspaper correspondent S Rahmonov said that "the cooperation between Uzbekistan and Sweden is of practical importance for the benefit of the parties. The Agreement on Encouragement and Mutual Protection of Investments signed between the Government of the Republic of Uzbekistan and the Government of the Kingdom of Sweden on 29 May 2001 serves as an important factor. Today there are about 10 enterprises with Swedish investors, which effectively operate in leading sectors of the economy, such as mining, energy, telecommunications, transport and construction materials. Hans-Werner Hunek, the rector of the Heidelberg Pedagogical Institute, said that there are more than 60 members of the German-Uzbek scientific society. At present, academic exchanges between Tashkent State University are intensifying. These universities also provide training for students, helping to develop joint programs for Germanistics in Uzbekistan. In the long run of the Goethe Institute in Tashkent, the Uzbek youth is working hard to teach the German language. It is especially important for every Uzbek family to appreciate that values such as timely fulfillment of German culture in culture, time saving, and timely accounting of books are valuable. Here are some of the commonly used expressions in the Germans' daily life, such as the phrase "the German word for accountability" is widely used in the speech of certain categories of Uzbeks.

Ph.D, professor B Goyibnazarov's article titled "Modernization and diversification of the industry provides the competitiveness of the economy", published in the newspaper "People's Word," states that "the Uzbek and German economies are very similar to each other." [See: People's Word, February 3, 2016 (6458)]. According to him, such similarities are observed in attracting investments. Investments cover all regions of the country. For this purpose, Sheveytsariyaning famous "Rieter", "Murata of Japan", "patches", "Mayer" German companies, high-efficiency machines with the establishment of modern enterprise

and reconstruction of large-scale significance. Region central to the development of the cotton-ginning plant on the basis of the proposed "joint venture" Deco Production him a clear example of the word [See: People's Word. February 25, 2017, №41 (6735)]. "In order to increase export alohiyatini foreign countries, particularly the United Nations Development Program, with the participation of experts of the German Society for International Cooperation, which represents the requirements of the export of fruit and vegetables to European countries has been published, they are more than 90 national standards for products based on the international ISO standards, combining" (See: People's Word, January 28, 2016, №28 (6454)). Cooperation between Uzbekistan and France

Currently, a joint venture with French Peugeot Citroen Automotive is being set up in Uzbekistan. For the construction of the plant 45 hectares of land were allocated to the Jizzakh economic zone. According to the bilateral

agreement, Peugeot Citroen Automotive will introduce new technologies and modern manufacturing processes and improve the skills of its employees. It is planned to complete the construction and assembly works by May 1, 2018. Starting from 2019, we will start production of new cars.

The plant will be able to produce up to 16,000 modern vehicles per year. Hereby, Uzavtosanoat joint stock company, specializing in the supply of automotive spare parts, is planning to use 50% of local products for attraction of about 30 large and over 160 small and medium-sized enterprises. Observations show that Uzbekistan has been focusing on the development of civil society in the European countries."Participation in the Roundtable on the Status and Prospects of the Development of Civil Society: Participation in the Roundtable on the Experience of Uzbekistan and France", organized by the Embassy of Uzbekistan in Paris [See: People's Word, 22 May 2016, №56 (6491)]. Another feature of the English language in Uzbekistan is the tendency for young people to communicate in English rather than Russian; translations are being made from original sources; the number of programs broadcasted in the English language has also increased in the media. It is likely that in the near future, the English language in Uzbekistan will make significant changes in the Uzbek text. Mavjuda Kholmatova's article entitled "The

Foreign Language Teaching System is improving" was published on April 23, 2016 in the newspaper "People's Word". It is noted that "Currently 9692 general education schools of Uzbekistan study English in foreign languages, including 8, 543 general education schools. For the 2015/2016 academic year, 641,000 copies of English language, more than 26,000 German books, 20,000 copies of French language textbooks and exercise books have been published for 1st grade students. The textbooks are being examined and perfected together with the British Council in Tashkent, the Goethe Institute and the French Embassy. [See: People's Word, April 23, 2016, № 80 (6515)]. Particularly, "Qisas ul-anbiyo" by Rabbani has been translated into English. We believe that such a large-scale effort is a decisive factor in rapprochement of relations between Europe and the European continent, which has a different culture, life and livelihood.
