Introduction. Empirical sociological research is one of the sociological methods. It is a comprehensive and holistic study of the social problem, based on its true, observed expression, in the image of actions and contemplation of individuals and groups, as well as on a specially structured and exactly the same problem plan, method and technique. The peculiarity of empirical sociological research is the collection of facts about the phenomena under study, direct contact with the individuals and their life activity.

Empirical sociological research is the study of questioning, questionnaires, observation, experiment and documentation, and the knowledge of sociometric techniques using experiment. We conducted an empirical study of the small group below using the sociometric method.

In working with the group, the study of the group's own interpersonal relationship, the state of alienation of group members from group activities is the main issue. Because in the various work processes and activities that are carried out with the group, it is important to have a group birdam.

Also, involvement of alienated members of the group activity in the group work process increases the effectiveness of working with this group. Because when working with school-age and student youth, it is necessary to avoid alienation from their group activities, because young people are prone to various external influences during this period.

It is also a very important issue that young people should not be alienated from group activities when today's diverse religious currents and the threat of religious fundamentalism are at stake.

Purpose of the study.

Based on the data of the conducted empirical sociological research, the emergence of alienation from group activity in student youth, the cause of the group members falling into this situation, the impact of individual attitude in the group is studied and analyzed. The outlook of the students of Karakalpak State University, their attitude to the activities of the group were determined.

The initial signs of alienation from group activities in student youth and the process of its origin were studied and analyzed.
